History & Mission: The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency opened its doors in downtown Washington, D.C., on December 2, 1970.

EPA scientists conduct tests on soil, air and water samples to determine the presence of pollutants and other contaminants. EPA microbiologists test drinking water to ensure its safety. Hospital disinfectants are tested to ensure the validity of their claims and chemists develop the analytical methods necessary to monitor pesticide residues in food. Science center staff also inspects and investigates manufacturing facilities, hazardous waste sites, and public and private labs.

EPA Environmental Science Center

The Environmental Science Center was completed in April 1999. The facility represents a partnership between Region 3 and EPA headquarters. The laboratory portion of the building is divided into 70 work areas dedicated to organic and inorganic chemistry, biology, microbiology, and other scientific activities. Approximately two thirds of the 70 laboratories at the facility support Region 3 personnel including Office of Analytical Services and Quality Assurance, and the Field Inspection Program. The remaining laboratories support Headquarters Office of Pesticides Program Personnel and the Baltimore resident office of EPA's Criminal Investigation Division.
