The Federal Emergency Management Agency can trace its beginnings to the Congressional Act of 1803. This act, generally considered the first piece of disaster legislation, provided assistance to a New Hampshire town following an extensive fire. In the century that followed, ad hoc legislation was passed more than 100 times in response to hurricanes, earthquakes, floods and other natural disasters. On April 1, 1979, President Jimmy Carter signed the executive order that created the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).

FEMA's mission is to support our citizens and first responders to ensure that as a nation we work together to build, sustain and improve our capability to prepare for, protect against, respond to, recover from and mitigate all hazards, whether natural or man-made, including acts of terror.

History & Mission: The National Emergency Training Center campus was acquired from Saint Joseph College by the federal government in March 1979. The NETC was created in 1980 and the first National Fire Academy classes were offered on January 21, 1980. Also that year, the former Defense Civil Preparedness Staff College was relocated from Battle Creek, Michigan. It reopened in January 1981 as EMI.

NETC is the educational arm of FEMA and the Department of Homeland Security and promotes the professional development of the fire and the emergency response community and its allied professionals. The NETC offers courses free of charge to those in emergency management and preparedness career fields throughout the country.

The U.S. Fire Administration (USFA), which administers both the NFA and EMI, strives to reduce the loss of life and property due to fire and related emergencies, through leadership, advocacy, coordination and support.
