History & Mission: Originally named Detrick Field in 1931, the airfield previously operated as an emergency airfield route and served as a Cadet Pilot Training Center. In 1943 the aviation operations were terminated, and the facility was renamed Camp Detrick. The facility expanded between 1946 and 1952 with new land purchase and facility construction and was later renamed Fort Detrick. The installation is on 1,200 acres.

Fort Detrick has had multiple National Security Missions since the 1940s. It supports five cabinet-level agencies: The Department of Defense, Department of Veterans Affairs, Department of Agriculture, Department of Homeland Security and Department of Health and Human Services. Within the Department of Defense (DoD), Fort Detrick supports elements of all four military services. Major Department of the Army mission partners include the US Army Medical Research and Materiel Command and the 21st Signal Brigade.

Forest Glen is the main annex to Fort Detrick, located in Silver Spring Maryland. Since 1999, Forest Glen has been home to the Walter Reed Army Institute of Research, Naval Medical Logistics Command, the National Museum of Health and Medicine, as well as other small units. The land for Forest Glen was originally acquired by the U.S. Army during World War II and was the originally home to the Walter Reed National Military Medical Center. The Forest Glen garrison is under the command of Fort Detrick.
