**History & Mission:** The history of Andrews Air Force Base dates back to the Civil War when the Union occupied a small country church as its headquarters for soldiers camped nearby. In 1942, President Franklin D. Roosevelt ordered the Secretary of War to acquire the land and to build a military airfield. In 1943, the first permanent unit, the 463rd Base Headquarters and Air Base Squadron, arrived from Westover Field, Mass., with 105 enlisted men and five officers. President Harry S. Truman was the first to fly a presidential flight out of Andrews in 1946. The port of entry and departure for dignitaries transferred to Andrews Air Force Base in 1959. In 2005, the Air Force reactivated the Air Force District of Washington (AFDW) as the single Air Force voice for planning and implementing Air Force and joint solutions within the National Capital Region (NCR). In 2009, Andrews Air Force Base, along with Naval Air Facility Washington, became a joint base known as Joint Base Andrews Naval Air Facility Washington, or Joint Base Andrews.

The facility is home to a number of units, such as the 316<sup>th</sup> Wing. The 316<sup>th</sup> Wing, the current host wing for the facility, provides security, personnel, contracting, finance and infrastructure support for six Wings, two Headquarters and more than 50 tenant organizations. Best known for special air missions, the facility provides transportation for senior government and military leaders, as well as presidents.

**Mission:** The Air Force District of Washington (AFDW) is the parent command to the 316<sup>th</sup> and 844<sup>th</sup> Communications group at Joint Base Andrews. AFDW provides personnel and support for Air Force activities within the National Capital Region (NCR) and approximately 33,000 Airmen and civilians performing duties in more than 500 locations across more than 100 countries. The 316<sup>th</sup> wing provides base-level services for three headquarters, five wings, more than 80 tenant organizations, and 60,000 Airmen/family members in the NCR and globally. The 11<sup>th</sup> Wing is home to the U.S. Air Force Band and Honor Guard missions, and the host unit, executes critical national security mission support for approximately 70 mission partners. Finally, the 844<sup>th</sup> Communications Group at Andrews provides communications, information technology systems, services and management to the Department of the Air Force, AFDW, National Military Command Center, and their tenant units.

**Mission:** The 316th Wing is the host wing for Joint Base Andrews providing security, personnel, contracting, finance and infrastructure support for 5 Wings, 3 Headquarters and more than 80 tenant organizations, as well as 60,000 Airmen and families in the national capital region and around the world. The 316th Wing supports contingency operations in our nation's capital with immediate response rotary-assets. It also provides security for the world's highest visibility flight line and is responsible for ceremonial support with the United States Air Force Band, Honor Guard and Air Force Arlington Chaplaincy in the National Capital Region.

The 316th Medical Group provides oversight for Air Force medics at military treatment facilities across Maryland, Virginia, and Washington, D.C. It has six subsidiary squadrons throughout the region. This includes a Aeromedical Staging Facility providing the reintegration of Soldiers, Sailors, Marines and Airmen giving them care for critically injured patients who require stabilization, advanced trauma resuscitation, and surgical intervention prior to transport to a definitive care facility. Its Air Force Altitude Chamber is one of only 11 in the Air Force and the only one located in the Northeast region. The medics of the 316th Medical Group provide support to Senior Leaders across the Air Force, White House, and the Department of Defense. Furthermore, the medics teach Self Aid and Buddy Care techniques to members of the presidential communication staff.
